



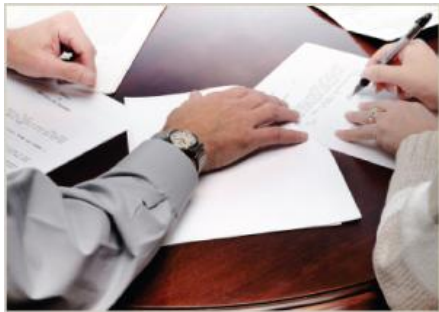

Administrative Activities Summary



During the month on April, Alderman Vandertie relayed information to the Community Service Unit about a possible partnership opportunity with Habitat for Humanity. After checking into the opportunity, we learned that Habitat for Humanity has a program to assist people in making necessary home repairs and painting, if they meet certain financial eligibility criteria. Unit administration changed our Code/Zoning Notice forms to include information on eligibility for the Habitat for

Humanity program, and how to apply for it. This program will help people who cannot perform required home repairs/painting on their own due to their physical and financial condition.
